1. INTRODUCTION

Harry Gwala Development Agency was established with a specific mandate to augment growth and development within the Harry Gwala District by improving the quality of life for the residents of District and promoting sustainable development.

2. PURPOSE OF THE BRIEF

The Agency seeks to procure the services of a suitably qualified service provider to supply, deliver and install aircons at the Harry Gwala Development Agency offices. The HGDA intends installing Air conditioning system in its offices to help maintain a comfortable indoor temperature, ensuring a conducive working environment. A Heating, Ventilation and Airconditioning (HVAC) system is a complete comfort system that can heat and cool office environment, as well as provide improved indoor air quality and humidity control. The appointed service provider will be expected to conduct site assessment and planning, preparation of the installation area, indoor unit mounting and connection to ductwork, installation of refrigerant lines and electrical connections, outdoor unit positioning and mounting, thorough system testing and setup. The service provider must be CIDB and ISO compliant

3. DETAILED SCOPE OF WORK

As part of the Agencies' mandate is to create an enabling environment and compliance with Occupational Health and Safety and Environmental Regulations for Workplace, the service provider will be installing the new Heating, Ventilation and Airconditioning (HVAC) system components, including connecting the electrical and refrigerant lines and testing the system to ensure it operates correctly. The offices where air conditioning units will be installed have no sufficient ventilation and this must be taken into consideration.

The types of air conditioners to be supplied, installed and maintained include x3 (three) 18000Btu and x6 (six) 9000Btu midwall split units and x1 (one) 48000Btu under ceiling inverter – 3 phase complete set. Servicing of air conditioners will be done at intervals to be communicated by the municipal entity. The service will be inclusive of labour and gas top-up.

The installation must include 20A din breaker, weather-proof 2Pole Isolator, 8M 2.5 + earth, 4M 20mm Bosal, 90-degree Bosal bend, saddles, PVC Glands, 20mm conduit and piping for water extraction to the outside per air conditioning unit. A copy of the purchase receipt of material if required must be attached to the service provider's invoice.

Proper installation is essential for the AC unit's performance and longevity.

4. COMPULSORY REQUIREMENTS

- The successful service provider will be required to complete the project within 14 days after appointment, failure to deliver within the time frame will result in order being cancelled.
- Appointed Service Provider to do site visit to identify suitable locations for aircons.
- The Service provider should have a Qualified HVAC Technician or be Registered with relevant Air Conditioning Bodies and be knowledgeable about installation of aircons.
- The service provider to quote for all electrical material.

- All work must be carried out in line with best practice for air conditioning maintenance, repairs, installations and must comply with all applicable and relevant legislation and regulations in the air-conditioning industry.
- The service provider must have CIDB grading level 1ME, applicable in the HVAC industry.
- The service provider must be registered with the South African Refrigeration and Air Conditioning Contractors Association (SARACCA).

Pmin = Price of lowest acceptable tender

3.2. FORMULAE FOR DISPOSAL OR LEASING OF STATE ASSETS AND INCOME GENERATING PROCUREMENT

3.2.1. POINTS AWARDED FOR PRICE

A maximum of 80 or 90 points is allocated for price on the following basis:

4. POINTS AWARDED FOR SPECIFIC GOALS

- 4.1. In terms of Regulation 4(2); 5(2); 6(2) and 7(2) of the Preferential Procurement Regulations, preference points must be awarded for specific goals stated in the tender.
