The primary objective is to acquire high-quality, energy-efficient inverter systems with suitable battery capacity to support essential office equipment and ICT infrastructure during outages. These systems must be durable, scalable, and compatible with the agency's current electrical setup. The installation must be carried out by a qualified service provider with proven expertise in backup power systems, and must include testing, user training, and maintenance support. This initiative aligns with HGDA's commitment to improving operational efficiency, maintaining uninterrupted service delivery, and ensuring compliance with occupational health and safety standards.

3. SCOPE OF WORK

The appointed service provider will be required to:

- Supply a hybrid inverter system with a lithium battery package
- Deliver the equipment to the specified site
- Install and configure the inverter system
- Test the system to ensure proper functionality
- Provide training and a basic user manual
- Offer technical support and warranty services

 or $Ps = 90\left(1 + \frac{Pt - Pmax}{Pmax}\right)$

Where

Ps = Points scored for price of tender under consideration

Pt = Price of tender under consideration

Pmax = Price of highest acceptable tender

4. POINTS AWARDED FOR SPECIFIC GOALS

- 4.1. In terms of Regulation 4(2); 5(2); 6(2) and 7(2) of the Preferential Procurement Regulations, preference points must be awarded for specific goals stated in the tender. For the purposes of this tender the tenderer will be allocated points based on the goals stated in table 1 below as may be supported by proof/ documentation stated in the conditions of this tender:
- 4.2. In cases where organs of state intend to use Regulation 3(2) of the Regulations, which states that, if it is unclear whether the 80/20 or 90/10 preference point system applies, an organ of state must, in the tender documents, stipulate in the case of—
 - (a) an invitation for tender for income-generating contracts, that either the 80/20 or 90/10 preference point system will apply and that the highest acceptable tender will be used to determine the applicable preference point system: or

CERTIFICATE OF INDEPENDENT BID DETERMINATION
